REQUESTING THE CAPTAIN & QUEEN

Each year the Terrace Riverboat Days Society selects a Captain and Queen to “preside” over the ten days of Riverboat Days. These are long term residents of the community who typically have a long history of volunteerism or have otherwise made significant contributions to this community’s development. Conferring these titles upon them is a way of saying thanks for their community service.

While Riverboat Days prides itself on being a fun and casual community festival, the Riverboat Days Society suggests the following protocol if the Captain & Queen are to attend your event:

- Try to inform all organizers/volunteers you have requested them to attend, especially those persons monitoring the door.
- Welcome them and ensure they have seats or appropriate placement to see your event.
- Entrance fees should not be charged the Captain & Queen.
- If there are additional costs to ‘attend’ your event we ask those also be waived.
- Consider including them in your event, even in a small way, such as participating in an opening ceremony or handing out prizes.
- If the Captain & Queen attends your event, we request that a picture is taken of them that the Riverboat Days Society can use for promotional purposes. Please send photos to **info@riverboatdays.ca**.

Please note: Captain & Queens are given a list of events where their appearance has been requested. Most do their best to attend as many events they are able. But please be aware there is no expectation that the Captain & Queen will attend.
